MISSION STATEMENT

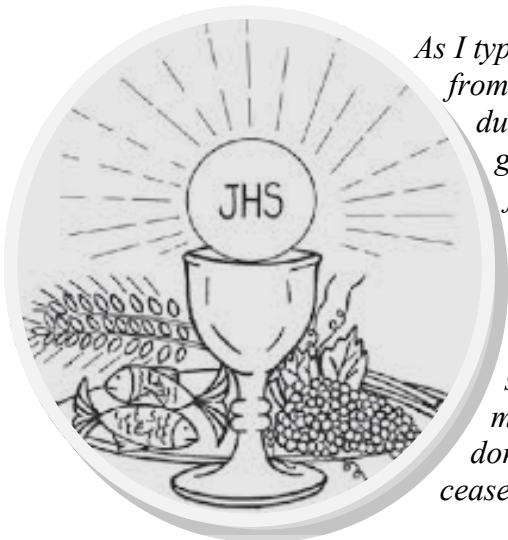

As I type these few words I am also typing (via Skype) with a friend from home who is in Kenya right now. I sent her a message during the week, thinking she was in Dublin and was happy to get an almost instant reply but shocked to discover she's so far away. I had no idea. I've just asked what she's doing and she tells me she's working with an Aid Agency that has over two hundred people working in various African countries. Her work involves connecting with these people, seeing how the work is going, listening to their suggestions and feedback and, based on that helping to make decisions around what is working and what could be done better. Decisions too about what should be changed or ceased.

Strikes me there's something of “Corpus Christi” here - seeking to be as one with people and through that seeking, doing something to nourish and strengthen people for the journey. It's about brining people together around strength and peace and wanting the world to be a better place. “I came”, he said, “that you might have life and have it to the full”.

We are made to be in communication with one another and to care about the other's journey. Skype can help with that, texts and emails too, visits of course but so too, and centre stage this weekend, “The Body of Christ”.

MAYO SOUTH WEST SICAP

Mayo South West, through the Social Inclusion Programme (SICAP) are offering opportunities for training to unemployed people and 'unemployed and not on the live register'. A number of people in the community are not on the Live Register (often if their spouse is claiming for them so they are not registered in their own right or if their partner is self employed) and they are unable to take advantage of training programmes to help them get into employment. This is one of the groups of people that the Social Inclusion Programme aims to help. Kilmovee Family Resource Centre works closely with Mayo South West and aims to help people to get back into employment. If you fall into this category and wish to move closer to gaining employment through training and improving work readiness, contact Kilmovee FRC and give us your details and we will be able to put you in touch with Mayo SW.
