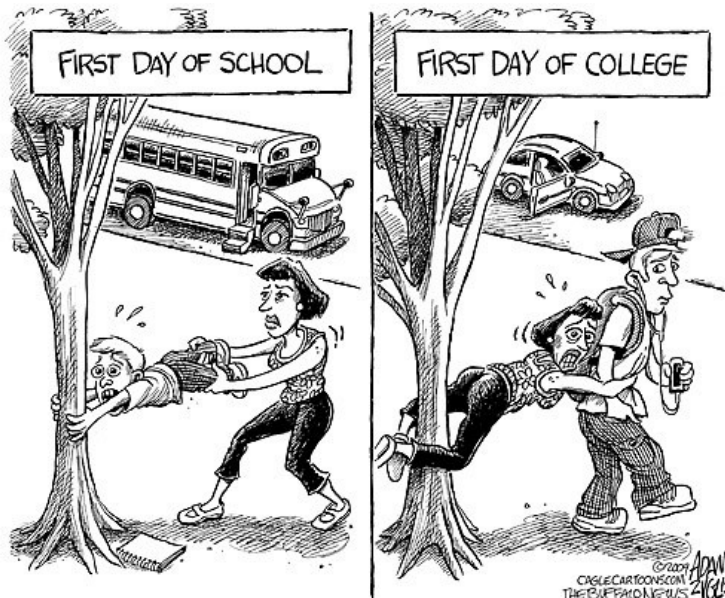
MISSION STATEMENT
