JOY IN GIVING

As our Pastoral Council prepares to change some of its members and as we reflect a little on some of the thoughts shared and promoted by the previous PPC, I am reminded of a decision taken some years ago to launch a “Christmas Food Appeal” to support the work of our local Conference of the St Vincent dePaul Society.

The idea quickly took hold and the response was staggering with in excess of sixty “food parcels” being prepared and delivered over the Christmas Season. It was

decided too, to bring a small token to each of the sick and housebound visited during the year. These “tokens” were taken from what was over and above the essentials a family might need around the Christmas Days. It was and remains a good idea and a noble act. It was all made possible through the generosity of our own people, wanting to help some of our own people who might have had a particular need at the time.

This weekend’s Gospel passage focuses us on that ongoing call to generosity. The “Widow’s Mite” as it has become known was the jingling sound of her last penny as she dropped into the Temple’s Collection Plate. It meant everything because it was everything. There was a personal cost and somewhere the vision to see that others might have needs. You’d like to believe, and I feel we can, that her act of selflessness did not go without reward as it had not gone without notice. Giving, more often than not, is the doorway to receiving.

Next weekend at all our Parish Masses, there will be representatives of our own Conference of St Vincent dePaul Society on hand seeking your financial support to assist them as they seek to assist others, not just at Christmas but throughout the year. Later on, we will again rely on your help with the, now annual, Christmas Food Appeal.
