Last year, at First Confessions I mentioned to the children that we had two students in Maynooth and I asked that they might say a prayer for “Paul or Stephen” as their penance. One boy asked “Can I say a prayer for both of them?” I assured him he could. Quite often, since then, I’ve been asked “How are Paul and Stephen?” They’re both doing well, thank God and this Sunday Paul will be ordained a priest of the Diocese of Achonry at 3pm in his native parish of Achonry-Mullinabreena. We rejoice with him on this most special day and pray God’s blessing on his ministry within our diocese.

Earlier this week, I called Paul and asked would he meet me in the church in Mullinabreena to share a few thoughts for our Diocesan Website. He readily agreed. Paul spoke so freely and eloquently about his vocation and traced it back to his earliest days serving Mass and the parish priest wondering if any of the servers had given thought to a vocation. This theme was picked up by other priests, family members and friends of Paul and eventually he felt he had to give it a try. Thank God he did.

God’s call to priesthood is so often heard in the local voice of family, neighbour and friend. If we are looking for dazzling lights or deafening words from the skies, chances are we’ll miss the call. It is so much more subtle than that. Listening to Paul the other day left me with a question - “when did I last suggest to anyone that he might make a good priest?” Sadly the answer did not come quickly. I did recall recently saying to someone that I thought her brother might make a good priest but I didn’t say it to the man himself! I’ll have to think a bit about that. Certainly it seems we all have quite a role to play in promoting vocations.
