### **DEFIBRILLATOR FOR KILKELLY**

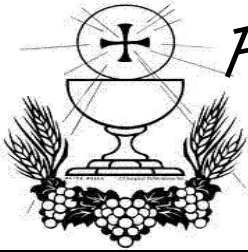

A Defibrillator is a necessity for all areas and with a quick response lives will be saved.
