28th Sunday in Ordinary Time – 15th October 2017



The invitation to the Lord's Table is a certain as life itself but there can be a great reluctance to accept.

This is not new nor unique to our time. This weekend's Gospel passage reminds us that there were always people unwilling to accept and disinterested in being part of the gathering.

Recently in our diocese there was a headcount taken, to get a general overview of the numbers of people attending weekend Masses. It was done over two weekends. Over the two weekends, based on the figures received from the parishes, an average of 8862 people attended seventy-seven Masses in the fifty churches of our diocese. In our own four churches, the combined average attendance was in the region of 350. Needless to say, the potential for a much higher attendance level is there.

We can see the potential that is there for fuller churches. Christmas, Easter, Funerals and sometimes Anniversary Masses remind us of what it is to have a full church. The atmosphere is totally transformed and there's literally life around us. The dream of larger congregations, more engagement and a livelier and lived faith must remain in our hearts. Otherwise we become dejected and run the risk of giving up hope.

Let us think about this together! How do we begin to invite again those who have stopped attending church? Of course, attendance is not the only measurement of Faith and it is possible people are going to other Masses but somewhere there's challenge to "invite" again and to encourage.

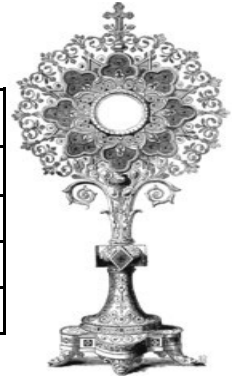
