### **JIVING JUNIORS**

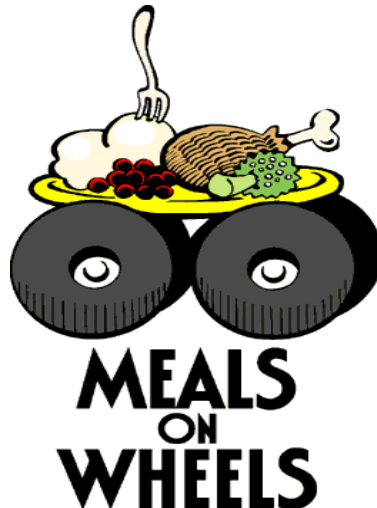

Gerard Coffey has offered to supply a heated box, costing approx €500. This box means that the unit will be weather-proof and kept at the same temperature at all times.
