On Sunday next, Palm Sunday, the priests of our Parish Cluster (Bohola, Carracastle, Charlestown, Kilmovee, Kiltimagh and Swinford) will be available to celebrate with you the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

There will be a priest, in some cases two, in each of the Parish Churches of the Cluster. This is an opportunity to celebrate God's forgiveness as we prepare for the great celebration of Holy Week and Easter.

Confessions will take place from 6pm and conclude at 7pm unless there is need to continue beyond that time.

The priests of our cluster are Fr Stephen O'Mahony (Bohola), Fr Gerry Davey (Carracastle), Frs Tommy Johnston and John Doherty (Charlestown), Fr Vincent Sherlock (Kilmovee), Frs Michael Quinn and Pat Lynch (Kiltimagh) and Frs Dermot Meehan and Michael Joyce (Swinford). Three of these priests (Frs John Doherty, Pat Lynch and Michael Joyce) are retired but continue to assist in the parishes where they live in retirement. We are indeed lucky to have them and grateful for their willingness to assist with ministry in this cluster.

On Palm Sunday evening the priests will travel to parishes within the Cluster to give our parishioners the opportunity of celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation with a priest, other than the usual priest in the parish.

At a Parish Pastoral Council Meeting, having looked at and discussed Holy Week and Easter in light of our changed Parish circumstances, the following timetable for Holy Week and Easter Ceremonies was adopted:

- **PALM SUNDAY**
Vigil and Sunday Masses as usual in **all** churches.
- **HOLY THURSDAY MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER:**
celebrated in **Kilmovee 8.00pm**
- **GOOD FRIDAY CELEBRATION OF THE PASSION:**
celebrated in **Kilmovee 3.00pm**
- **HOLY SATURDAY CELEBRATION OF EASTER VIGIL:**
celebrated in **Kilkelly 9.00pm**
- **EASTER SUNDAY MASSES:** **Urlaur: 9.00am**
Kilmovee: 10.30am
Glann: 12noon

This means that we will not have the Easter Vigil in Kilmovee this year or an Easter Sunday Mass in Kilkelly. Ideally we would love to have ceremonies in all the churches but, as you can appreciate, this is not possible.

The hope and prayer is that, where practical, people will attend as many of the Holy Week Ceremonies as they can in the churches of the parish. You might consider offering a lift to neighbours who might not have ready access to transport. In this way, not alone will you be attending the Holy Week Ceremonies but you will be sharing the Lord's call to prayer in bringing others with you.
