PARISH FINANCES 2020 - AN OVERIVEW (January-December 2020)

t this time of the year, the parish makes its financial returns to the Diocese.

Thank you for your support of the parish at all times and, in particular, during 2020 which was such a hugely challenging year for us all.

Looking at the overall picture of our parish finances, in 2020 we collected €57,130.00 in our weekly Offertory Donations (this marks a reduction of €18,742.00 on the previous year) which reflects the reality that our churches were closed for much of the year. It must be pointed out that, in addition to this amount, €14,217.00 was received through direct donations last year - most notably towards webcam, church donations and towards the works carried out on the roof of Kilkelly Church) - needless to say, these were a significant boost to us and reflect again, your ongoing generosity. The works carried out to Kilkelly Church Roof were our main expense of last year (€33,544.00). Our insurance company made a contribution of €5500.00 towards the repairs. Our regular costs included insurance (€7717 - paid in instalments this year by arrangement with Allianz - the annual cost of insurance is in excess of $\in 10,000.00$ and final instalment had not been paid by end of 2020), heating ($\in 1920.00$), electricity (€8802.00 - includes electric heating in Kilmovee and Urlaur Churches) etc also had to be met. We had some additional costs around providing equipment, maintaining sanitizing supplies etc in response to COVID-19 (totalling just over €3,000.00). Our webcam installation and monitoring for the year cost €3000.00. Office supplies, materials for newsletter publication, supply of ink etc totalled €2844.00 and upgrading and maintenance of security systems (Parochial House and Curate's House) as well as fire extinguisher service came to €1346.00. Printing and Supply of Offertory Envelopes was €1093.00, installation of Fibre Broadband and monthly service came to €1149.00 - this facilitated the livestreaming from our Parish Church and supplies broadband to the Parochial House). Church Supplies (Candles, Altar Breads, Altar Wine and items required in our churches for Liturgical Use) came to €2843.00). €14,282.00 was paid to the Diocesan Central Fund. These are just some of the major outlays that are part of parish life. Other lesser costs are not included here but are part of the annual outlay. Total parish expenditure for 2020 was €82,827.15 while income was €83,017.00 - primarily from weekly Offertory Contributions, Candelabra, Individual once-off Donations and the insurance contribution to Kilkelly Church Roof so we had a marginal profit of €189.85

Thank you for your support, hopefully the above gives you a sense of the financial situation in our parish.
