An Garda Siochána have been made aware of members of the public having received fraudulent text messages and telephone calls regarding Covid 19 vaccination. The text messages and phone calls have made requests for people to confirm private and sensitive information such as PPS number, date of birth and address. The HSE will never

text or call individuals requesting personal info. They will never request payment for a Covid test or vaccine. Your local GP will be your first point of contact about the vaccine or Covid testing. The Covid 19 vaccine is free and it is not available privately. We would ask members of the public to share this information, especially with those who may be vulnerable.
