Churches Open for Public Worship

An Taoiseach, Michéal Martin TD, has written to church leaders this week. He outlines the intention of the Government to facilitate the reopening of our churches for Public Worship. An announcement will be made on May 4th, in lines with NPHEAT advice. He commends all church leaders and people of faith for the efforts made by all to protect life in these times and praises, in particular, the efforts made by church leaders and parishes to ensure people's safety when attending church. Once again, he asks that all parishes take similar steps and precautions as we prepare for the reopening. This is welcome news and offers us all much needed hope at this time. The number permitted to attend funerals will rise from 10 to 25 before May 4th.

PREPARING FOR CONFIRMATION

PIt has been decided that the Sacrament of Confirmation this year will be celebrated in Autumn. Bishop Paul, feels this will offer us all a better chance to be in a place where as many as possible can celebrate this special moment in the lives of our young people.
