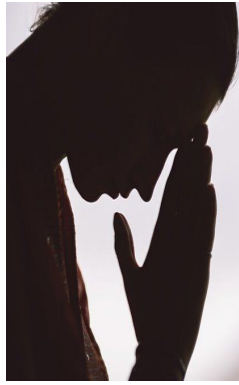

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION 2021

We had hoped to celebrate First Holy Communion on June 12th but decided that in keeping with Government and NPHEAT advice that we might be better to postpone the celebration until the Autumn. This is done in the interests of all and we look forward to a parish celebration later in the year. First Penance will be celebrated in the three schools in advance of the Summer Holidays. Please keep the children of our First Holy Communion classes as well as the boys and girls of our Confirmation Classes in your prayers. When the day of celebration comes for them all, our prayer is that they will welcome Jesus in the Eucharist and the fullness of the Gifts and Fruits of the Holy Spirit. Our prayers can truly accompany them now as they look forward to their special days.

WORSHIPPING TOGETHER

Thank you to all who have returned to public worship in recent weeks. It is truly wonderful to see so many of you again and hear you joining with one another in prayer. The guidelines laid down for us remain as before,

- **Facemasks to be worn in church.**
- **Social Distancing**
- **Two people to a seat - though family members can sit together.**
- **Sanitising hands when entering and leaving the church**
- **Limited to fifty people in attendance at Mass**
- **Avoidance of gatherings after Mass**

We will get through this together. It is important that we follow these guidelines to the fullest of our ability. Stewarding in our churches will be kept at a discreet level but co-operation is the key.

The system we have in place, with daily Masses in Kilmovee and Kilkelly and weekend Masses as normal, allows for people to attend Mass on different days, thereby lessening any stress on the limit of fifty in attendance at any Mass.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

Monday June 14th will see the resumption of Adoration of The Blessed Sacrament in our parish. Initially we will have adoration in Kilmovee and Glann Churches with a view to doing so in Kilkelly and Urlaur at a later date. Thank you to those who have said they are happy to return to this adoration. We will have more details in the next week or two.

As soon as possible we will take a look at putting a finance committee in place in the parish. I am thankful to those who offer their services and have assisted in this work. Going

forward, we need to establish a committee and if you have expertise or experience in this area, I would be happy to hear from you.
