TAX RECLAIM FORMS

A word of thanks to those who have sent in tax reclaim forms. This will be of great benefit to the parish. If you have been donating to the parish via the envelope system and have donated a minimum of €250.00 per year and are paying tax, the parish can reclaim the tax paid on your donations. This is at no additional cost to you and just involves you signing a form, giving the parish permission to reclaim this tax. If you did not receive a form and feel this scheme may be an option for you, please let me know and I will arrange to get a form to you. We can make a claim for each year since 2017.
