

WALKING THE OLD WAYS IN KILMOVEE

Kilmovee Heritage celebrated National Heritage Week $2021\ 14^{th}-22^{nd}$ August with two free guided walks of the sites and monuments on our ancient Heritage Trail. Participants on the guided tour were treated to the facts and folklore that make the Kilmovee landscape such a fascinating and important area of cultural heritage.

The trail has a unique group of archaeological features spanning nearly 6,000 years of history.

From the ancient outdoor cooking sites to the rare triple Bullaun stone, the 5th century Ogham stone and the mighty Kilcashel stone fort, the history of the area was brought to life through storytelling.

One of the participants, who grew up in the area said "It was a great, informative day out. I used to play in the cashel when I was young and I never knew we had such amazing history around here".

Thank you to all who came along and made the guided tours so enjoyable. Kilmovee Heritage would also like to acknowledge Mayo Genealogy Group and the National Museum of Country Life for choosing Kilcashel stone fort as the image for the *Daoine agus Áit – Connecting our Communities* project.
