THE TRIUMPH OF THE CROSS September 14th

"Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that whoever believes in Him may have eternal life." John 3; 14-5

During Lent and Holy Week we take time to honor the cross. On Good Friday we kiss the cross on which Jesus suffered and died. 
