THE TRIUMPH OF THE CROSS

September 14<sup>th</sup>

*"Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that whoever believes in Him may have eternal life." John 3; 14-5*

During Lent and Holy Week we take time to honor the cross. On Good Friday we kiss the cross on which Jesus suffered and died. On September 14<sup>th</sup> we honour the glorious cross as a symbol of our redemption.
