The Rosary Priest

The family that prays together stays together.

Fr Patrick Peyton was known the world over as "The Rosary Priest". As a seminarian he had been cured of tuberculosis during a novena to Our Lady, and as a priest he wanted to tell the families of the world what she would do for them if they would open their hearts and their homes to her by praying the Rosary as a family every day. He spoke softly in his native Irish brogue. He delivered his message with such humility, simplicity and faith that millions committed themselves to pray the family Rosary every day. They considered the time they spent in his presence and heard him speak as a previous gift of Divine Grace.

After a long priestly ministry and preaching to millions at his worldwide Rosary Rallies, he died on June 3rd 1992. His Cause of Canonisation was officially opened on June 1st 2001, and he now has the title "Servant of God".

We invite you to join the thousands of people around the world who recite the family Rosary, especially during the month of October. We pray for his canonisation and for favours through his intercession.
