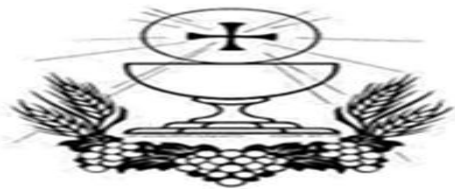
**SMART TECH SKILLS
