PRAYING FOR THE DEAD

November is a time for remembering and praying for our loved ones who have gone before us and whose loss we feel. It is a time when we are particularly conscious of those in our community who are grieving and all those families who have lost loved ones in the past year. More than most years, this November will be especially poignant as we remember all those who have died during the COVID-19 pandemic.

November is traditionally a month in which we remember our Loved Ones in prayer and include their names on the Altar List of the Dead. A Novena of Masses is being celebrated in our parish for all those whose names have been placed on the Altar List of the Dead. We remember the words of St Monica *"All I ask, that wherever you may be, you may remember me at the Altar of Lord"*.

The tradition reminds us that our community is connected to those who have died and reinforces our hope in the Resurrection. *"We believe in the communion of all the faithful of Christ, those who are pilgrims on earth, the dead who are purified, and the blessed in heaven, altogether forming one Christ."* (Paul VI)
