The Sacrament of Penance

Advent is a penitential season, a time for repentance and conversion, an opportunity to reflect, examine our conscience and seek out the mercy and forgiveness of Christ. In the Sacrament of Penance we encounter God as the Father of mercy as in the Parable of the Prodigal Son. The Father rushes out to meet us; He embraces us, holds us dear and rejoices in our return.
