"This is Joseph, the humble and diligent servant of the son of God"

The nativity scene that depicts the birth of Jesus Christ holds a very special place in our hearts. And often it doesn't even matter if the manger scene is big or small; a crib of any size is sure to lift our spirits. This year is a very special one indeed because it is the year dedicated to St. Joseph.

Usually the Baby Jesus and Our Lady take centre stage in the manger, with St. Joseph slightly marginalized, but Pope Francis has decided that this is the **"Year of St. Joseph"** and wrote an Apostolic Letter called **"With a Father's Heart"** because Joseph said "Yes" to God many times, and that has had a deep impact in the history of Salvation.

Who is St. Joseph? Joseph is the Carpenter from Nazareth who said "Yes" to Mary out of pure love for her; he is the man who answered "Yes" to the angel, and trusted that heavenly creature even when the advice was not entirely clear to him. For Jesus "Joseph was the earthly shadow of the heavenly Father" writes Pope Francis. Joseph took upon himself an immense responsibility with great humility, just like those unsung heroes who, even today, are making our world better for others...often without the world ever noticing of rewarding them. **St Joseph – Please pray for us.**
