**Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2022**

The theme of this years' Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is: "we saw His star in the East"

The story of the Three Wise Kings visiting the Holy Family in Bethlehem is one we are all familiar with as we have recently celebrated the Feast of the Epiphany. These Kings have been seen as a symbol of the world's diversity – different religions and cultures – that comes to pay homage to the Christ-Child. Their story might therefore represent a unity of all created human beings that God desires. They travel from far off countries and yet they are driven by the same hunger to see and know Jesus the new born King. In this we find a metaphor for Christian Unity: that is of different peoples drawn together in the common search to recognise Christ, to know him and to worship him and witnessing to the wider need for unity and to overcome injustices. This resulted because they claimed they had seen His star in the East and had followed it to successfully experience the joy of worshipping Jesus. During **this Week of Prayer for Christian Unity** we too can follow His star to the stable in Bethlehem and worship Jesus.
