Pope Francis officially opened the Synod last October and over the next two years there will be a series of local, regional and international phases of consultation concluding with the Bishops Meeting in Rome in October 2023. This process is about being open to the Holy Spirit as we journey together. As Christians we are baptised into the life and death of Jesus and it is from this baptism that we all receive our missionary mandate.
