LENT TIME OF PENANCE

During this season of Lent we have an opportunity each year to focus on Jesus and to celebrate his life, death and resurrection. Our Irish Bishops have recommended the following penances for us to consider during Lent.

- Visiting the Blessed Sacrament.
- Making the Stations of the Cross.
- Abstaining from alcohol or luxury foods.
- Making a special effort for family prayer.
- Helping the poor, sick, old or lonely people.
- Making an effort to attend Masses during the week.
- Fasting from all food for a longer period than usual and perhaps giving what is saved to the needy.
- Supporting the annual Trócaire collection.
