In Joseph we see an ideal combination of inner strength and gentleness of character. In a world where women are subjected to violence we see Joseph, somebody who is respectful, protective and supportive in his role as the legal father of Jesus and the husband of Mary. In his relationship with God, Joseph readjusts his plan to coincide with the broader picture of the salvation that God is bringing about.

Not surprisingly Pope Pius IX declared Joseph as the Patron of the Catholic Church.
