Palm Sunday 10th April 2022 The Crucifixion

So, Jesus came out wearing the crown of thorns and a purple robe. Pilate said to them "He is the man!" When the chief priests and the guards saw Him, they shouted "Crucify Him, Crucify Him!"

John 19:5-6

As we begin Holy Week, we celebrate the suffering and death of Jesus on Palm Sunday and Good Friday. It is important at least once a year to meditate on this story from the Bible. It is an amazing story of courage and great love on the part of Jesus, of anger and violence on the part of the mob and of a lack of courage by Pilate. It is a major part of our story as Christians which we commemorate during this Holy Week. Let us reflect quietly and read the Gospel account of the Crucifixion as though we have never heard it before. Feel the fear of the disciples and apostles, the calmness and commitment of Jesus, the anger of the crowd and Pilate's wavering over what to do with Jesus Christ.

Let us pray: Jesus, man of fortitude and God of love, teach me to be ever consistent in my beliefs and convictions in you during this Holy Week. Amen
