"I have seen the Lord"

Mary Magdalene went and announced to the disciples, "I have seen the Lord" John 20:18

Mary Magdalene encountered the Lord on Easter Sunday at the tomb. Yet at first she didn't recognise Him. Like Mary, it can be hard for us to recognise Christ when we encounter Him.
