TRINITY SUNDAY 12th June 2022

On this Trinity Sunday we reflect on who is your God.

It is He whom we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone in all wisdom, so that we may present everyone mature in Christ. For this I toil and struggle with all the energy that He powerfully inspires within me. - Colossians 1:28–29

St Paul was so fired up about God that he hurried from place to place preaching the good news. And when he couldn't be with a particular community in person, he wrote them letters about Christ's teachings. Because of his experience with Christ on the road to Damascus (see Acts 9:1-19), St Paul was sure of who God was. Each of us has our own image of God based on what we have been taught and what we have experienced. How would you draw a picture of God? Would it be the same picture you would have drawn when you were five or ten years old? Has your idea of God matured as you have?

Let us Pray: Jesus Christ, you are the visible image of the invisible God. Help me to grow in my understanding of God by knowing you better through God's word.
