Jesus asks us to come to Him with our needs. He offers us Himself as the bread of life in the Eucharist, and He is there with so much more for us when we ask.

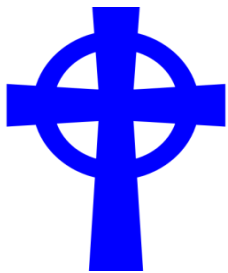
What kind of “bread” do you especially need to be fed with just now?
