St Thomas, Apostle

"Unless I see the mark of the nails in His hands, and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in His side, I will not believe" John: 20:25

This remark has caused Thomas to be remembered as Doubting Thomas. This is the same Apostle who, when he thought Jesus would be killed if he returned to Judea, wanted to go with Jesus to be killed alongside Him. (*John 11:16*). That sounds like two different people!
