Triumph of the Holy Cross

“Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in Him may have eternal life.”

This quotation from St John's Gospel reminds us of the importance of the Cross of Jesus Christ. During Lent and Holy Week we take a special time to honour the cross while on Good Friday we venerate the cross on which Jesus suffered and died. On September 14th we honour the glorious Cross, the symbol of our redemption because the Cross is viewed in the light of Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday morning.
