1st October, Saint Therese of the Child Jesus Patroness of the Missions

St Therese had a simple yet powerful message but still resonates in the heart of millions of today. Therese saw herself as a child of God. She liked to keep things simple and focused as a child does. Trust, especially, trust in God, is a childlike virtue. Therese's spirituality was simple and she called it her "little way". She believed and taught us that life presents enough challenges and opportunities for grace.
