Mission Sunday

"You shall be my witnesses" Acts 1:8

The title of the message refers to the Risen Jesus' last conversation with his disciples, before ascending to Heaven.. "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8). This is the heart of Jesus' teaching to the disciples regarding their mission in the world. The disciples are to be witnesses of Jesus in every place and situation, thanks to the grace of the Holy Spirit that they will receive. Christ was the first to be sent, as a "missionary" of the Father (Jn 20:21), and as such, he is the Father's "faithful witness" (cf. Rev 1:5).

In a similar way, every Christian is called to be a missionary and witness to Christ. The Church's only mission, as the community of Christ's disciples, is to bring the Gospel to the entire world by bearing witness to Christ. Each baptised person is called to mission, in the Church.
