Fourth Sunday of Advent

December 18th 2022

Psalm 23(24):1-6

"Let the Lord enter! He is the king of glory."

The 'Good News' lay hidden and veiled within from the beginning. The Hebrew prophets were signed a signpost pointing to its gradual unfolding in Israel's history. Take Isaiah for example. "Behold, the virgin will conceive and bear a son, and shall call him Immanuel" (Isaiah 7:14). The name Immanuel means "God with us". The mystery kept hidden and fully revealed in the fullness of time is God made man, who suffered, died and rose again. The incarnation is a central truth of Christian faith. Flesh and blood, mere reason alone, cannot grasp the mystery of God made man. The gift of a revelation allows us to bow down before this sacred mystery. The Psalms, so full of praise capture beautifully the impulse of the heart to give praise and glory to God our Saviour.
