Do as I have done

"So, if I, your Lord, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have set you an example, that you also should do as I have done to you." St John

The Apostles' feet were dirty from walking in open sandals on dusty roads and paths. Imagine Jesus kneeling down and washing each Apostles' feet before they ate their Supper. What He did was an act of great love and service which is an example for each one of us to reflect on during Lent. Imagine a carer working in a nursing home, and sometimes when they bathe patients, they find it an unpleasant task. Some patients may be cranky or frustrated and some may be in pain when they are moved. It would be important for the carer to remember this story about Jesus when they feel impatient. Let's remember this powerful witness of Christ.

Holy Spirit, you call us to see each person as sacred. So even the most basic – and possibly unpleasant – acts of service for another person are not demeaning acts but sacred ones in the eyes of the Gospel. Amen.
