Good News in Action

"Go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the world" Mark 16:15

The challenge is to proclaim the good news so it is perceived as good news by those who hear it. In a nutshell, the good news of the Gospel, as proclaimed in the life, death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, is that each of us is loved and cherished by God. Sometimes we proclaim the good news not with words but with actions. Sticking with a friend through hard times is one way of helping the person know that she/he is cherished by God as well as by us. At another time our action may involve remaining loyal to a friend when others turn against her/him. Proclaiming the good news is seen in words and in actions.
