Promises of the Heart

*But this is the covenant that I will make
with the house of Israel after those days,
says the Lord: I will put my law within them,
and I will write it on their hearts. – Jeremiah 31:33*

Remember how the covenant that God made with the Israelites was inscribed on stone tablets? Today we often summarise it as the Ten Commandments. About 700 years after God made that covenant with Israel, God spoke to Jeremiah and said a new covenant was coming that would be written on the people's hearts.
