OUR LADY OF KNOCK

At about 8 o'clock on Thursday evening the 21st August 1879, the Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Joseph and St. John the Evangelist appeared at the South gable of the Parish Church at Knock, County Mayo. Beside them and a little to the right was an altar with a cross and the figure of a lamb, around which angels hovered. There were fifteen official witnesses to the apparition – young and old – who watched it for two hours in pouring rain and recited the Rosary.

Two Commissions of Enquiry accepted their testimony as trustworthy and satisfactory in 1879 and 1936.

Today, Knock ranks as among the world's major Marian and Eucharistic Shrines, having enjoyed the full approval of the Church, for many years. It has received privileges from five Popes amongst the most recent was the visit of His Holiness, Pope Francis in 2018.
