Mission Sunday-22nd October 2023

For this year's World Mission Sunday Pope Francis has chosen the theme inspired by the story of the two disciples on the way to Emmaus, in the Gospel of St Luke: "Hearts on Fire, Feet on the Move" The two disciples were confused but their encounter with Christ sparked in them the enthusiastic desire to set out again towards Jerusalem and proclaim that the Lord Jesus had truly risen. In the Gospel account, we perceive this change in the disciples through a few revealing images: their hearts burned within them as they heard the Scriptures explained by Jesus, their eyes were opened as they recognised Him and, ultimately, their feet set out on His way.

This Mission Sunday, we remember our missionaries who serve people, many of whom live in abject poverty. This fact challenges us that they cannot cope by themselves because hunger and poverty are omnipresent. For this reason, we offer our prayers and resources to assist them in their stressful and unfortunate situation.
