Month of the Missions

Pope Francis has chosen the theme “Hearts on fire, feet on the move” for this year’s Mission Sunday. Inspired by the story of the disciples on the way to Emmaus (Lk 24:13-35): “Those two disciples were confused and dismayed, but their encounter with Christ in the word and in the breaking of bread sparked in them the enthusiastic desire to set out again towards Jerusalem and proclaim that the Lord had truly risen.”

The Church dedicates the month of October to this missionary endeavor. It culminates with the celebration of World Mission Sunday on October 22nd. This focus on mission offers to each of us the opportunity to reflect on how we are all called to share the missionary life of the Church.

Wherever we are and by the response we make to Christ, we are being missionary. How we live and give witness to Christ is very important. St Francis of Assisi remarks “preach the Gospel and if necessary, use words.” A salutary piece of wisdom.
