Second Sunday of Advent

Advent: A time of waiting

Advent is a time of waiting, conversion and joyful hope:

waiting - memory of the first, humble coming of the Lord in our mortal flesh; and also waiting - supplication for his final, glorious coming as our Lord and our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

conversion, to which the liturgy at this time often refers quoting the prophets, especially John the Baptist, 'Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is near at hand,'

joyful hope that the salvation already accomplished by Christ and the reality of grace in the world will mature and reach their fullness thereby granting us what is promised by faith and 'we shall become like him for we shall see him as he really is'. Popular piety is particularly sensitive to Advent, especially when seen as the memory of the preparation of the coming of the Messiah in the Old Testament, while the Christian people are deeply conscious of the long period of expectation that preceded the birth of our Saviour in the New Testament.
