First Sunday of Advent 3rd December 2023 **Advent:** A time of waiting

Advent has a twofold character, it is a time of preparation for the Solemnity of Christmas, in which the First Coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered. For this reason, Advent is a period of devout and expectant joy.

Our Advent Wreath helps us prepare for Christmas. Placing four candles on green foliage has become a symbol of Advent in many Christian homes especially in Europe and North America. The Advent Wreath with the progressive lighting of it's four candles, Sunday after Sunday, until the Solemnity of Christmas, is a recollection of the various stages of salvation history prior to the coming of Christ and a symbol of the prophetic light gradually illuminating the long nights prior to the rising of the Sun of Justice symbolized by the white candle in the centre of the Advent Wreath.
