The family that prays together stays together.

Fr Patrick Peyton was known the world over as the “Rosary Priest”. As a seminarian he had been cured of tuberculosis during a Novena to Our Lady and as a priest he wanted to tell the families of the world what she would do for them if they would open their hearts and their homes to her by praying the rosary as a family every day. He spoke softly in his native Irish brogue. He delivered his message with such humility, simplicity and faith that millions committed themselves to pray the Family Rosary daily.

They considered the time they spent in Fr Peyton’s presence and heard him speak, as a precious gift of Divine Grace. After establishing the Family Rosary Theatre in Hollywood and preaching to millions in his worldwide Rosary Rallies, he died in June 1992. His cause for canonisation was officially opened by the Vatican in June 2001.

We thank God for the graces he sought for families who pray together.
