Lenten Penance

St Augustine heard children singing a ditty, *'Tolle Lege. Tolle Lege'* (*'Take up and read, Take up and read.'*) and his eyes fell upon a verse from St Paul's Letter to the Romans, which was open on his desk: *'The night is nearly over, the day is almost here. So let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armour of light.'*

This moment led to St Augustine's conversion and to a life dedicated to God. How do we put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armour of light?
