St Davog

St Davog is remembered as the founder of the original monastery at Lough Derg, Co. Donegal sometime before 500AD. Tradition places him as a Welshman who came to Ireland in the company of St Patrick, when he returned as a missionary bishop and he is named among ‘the Twelve Apostles of Ireland’ in later sources.

His monastery was located on the later **Saints Island**, near the lough shore, while **Station Island** served as a desert or place apart for the monks in their times of more intense spiritual endeavour. The cave that served as their shelter here was located where the bell tower now stands, and it became famous across Europe from the twelfth century as St Patrick’s Purgatory.
