St Teresa of Calcutta (1910-1997)

St Teresa of Calcutta was born Skapje in Albania and at 18 years of age came to Rathfarnham Abbey in Dublin to become a Sister of Loreto, with the singular desire to become a missionary in India. She went to India the following year in 1929 where she taught English for 20 years, always with the goal of helping the poorest of the poor.

Taking the religious name Teresa after St Teresa of Lisieux who is patron of the missions, she later became known as ‘Mother Teresa’.

Later when she left teaching in the Loreto school she founded her religious congregation, the Missionaries of Charity in 1950 to serve the hungry, the unwanted and the dying who lived on the streets of Calcutta. Often her Christian faith was tested, her words and actions criticised, yet she was always certain in remaining a servant of Christ who reached out to the poor. The Missionaries of Christ now number 5000 Sisters in 130 countries. Mother Teresa, as she is universally known, is an outstanding witness of Christ reaching out to our suffering brothers and sisters in Christ.
